

Visit Meiji Jingu Shrine, Tokyo's most famous Shinto Shrine dedicated to the late 19th-century emperor who opened Japan to the West, home to a 40-foot-high torii gate and a 200-acre park made of 1,500-year-old cypress. Next, proceed to Tsukiji Market, the former site of the world's largest fish market, now a vibrant marketplace filled with produce and seafood stands and sushi joints. Continue to Tokyo's oldest Buddhist Temple at Senso-ji in Asakusa followed by a stroll thru its colorful Nakamise Shopping Street.

Last stop of the day is Ueno famed for its Ueno Park comprised temples & shrines, museums, and a zoo. Afterwards, take a stroll through nearby Ameya-Yokocho market that boasts an array of local eats and fresh seafood stands. Return to your hotel. (B)

This morning, proceed to Tokyo Station for your Shinkansen to Kyoto. Upon arrival, be met at Kyoto Station by your guide and commence sightseeing of Kyoto. Visit Fushimi Inari Shrine, famous for its thousands of vermilion torii gates straddling a network of trails behind its main buildings leading into the wooded forest of the sacred Mount Inari.

Next, continue to Kiyomizu Temple, one of the most celebrated temples of Japan founded in 780 on the site of the Otowa Waterfall in the wooded hills east of Kyoto. This UNESCO world heritage site is best known for its wooden stage that juts out from its main hall, 13 meters above the hillside below boasting panoramic views of Kyoto City. Enjoy a stroll through the two famous shopping streets (Ninen-zaka & Sannen-zaka) before reaching Yasaksa Shrine. Take a short stroll around Gion District before checking-in to your hotel in Kyoto. (B)

This morning, make your own way to Kyoto Station where you'll be met by your guide who will accompany you on a 30-minute train ride to Lake Biwa. Here, we'll spend a relaxing and culturally-inspiring day in a traditional farm village mingling with the locals. The tour showcases a slow-paced, off-the-beaten-path experience of the countryside to see a different side of Japan.

Your Lake Biwa experience begins with a leisurely bike ride along a beautiful lakeside road up to the stunning rice terraces. Next, visit a local family's residence where we'll enjoy some Mochi-making (Japanese dessert) fun and mingle with the locals. They will first demonstrate Mochi rice cake making following traditional methods and using homegrown rice, then it's your turn to try hand at making your own. It's an experience you'll never forget! Afterwards, enjoy some farm-to-table specialty Sukiyaki (hotpot) made with lots of homegrown vegetables. The farmer will show you how to make it so you bring home their secret recipe. Return to Kyoto on your own the same way. (B,L)

Morning at leisure to relax, enjoy breakfast and people watch. This afternoon, enjoy a city tour of Hanoi, a city of lakes, parks and colonial mansions, Hanoi retains much of its historical charm and, with an eclectic mix of Asian tempo and French refinement, tantalizing foods and a great place to observe typical Vietnamese life.

Our visits today include the 11th century Temple of Literature Vietnam's first university; One Pillar Pagoda, an iconic Buddhist temple known for its unique architectural design featuring a single pillar rising from a lotus pond; Visit Hoa Lo Prison (a.k.a. 'Hanoi Hilton'), where the late John McCain spent 5 years in captivity during the Vietnam War, followed by a cyclo (rickshaw) ride through the city's Old Quarter that boasts a labyrinth of quaint streets and alleyways lined with shops of all trades.

After touring around the city, it's time for some delicious eats for which Hanoi is known. Hanoi is the birthplace of many quintessential Vietnamese dishes and the city is considered one of the world's great food capitals, and sampling street food here is a must!

Your foodies adventure features a top 5 Master Chef who will accompany you to explore the capital's rich flavors expressed in every bite. Stroll through narrow streets sitting on tiny plastic chairs and enjoying a cup of Vietnamese coffee like the way locals start their day. Step in a traditional bustling market, learn which ingredients create the unique taste of these dishes and how they fit into the local culture. We'll sample around a dozen of seasonal street foods before ending the night over a glass of cold beer! (B,D)





## HCM City (Cu Chi Tunnels)

If you're up for an early start (4:45am pick-up), experience the beauty and tranquility of Angkor Wat at Sunrise. Angkor Wat, the crown jewel of Khmer architecture and the national symbol of Cambodia. Angkor Wat is the largest, best preserved, and most religiously significant of the Angkor temples. Angkor impresses visitors both by its sheer scale and beautifully proportioned layout, as well as the delicate artistry of its carvings. Angkor Wat is stunning at any time of the day, but sunrise and sunset are especially beautiful times to watch the play of light on the stones.

We will return to your hotel in time for Breakfast. Next, a visit to Angkor Thom, the ancient royal city of the Khmer Empire with its centerpiece; the Bayon temple. Continue to the Terrace of the Elephants, which served as a platform from where the King could welcome back his victorious army and the Terrace of the Leper King, which holds perfect carvings winding along a narrow passageway that leads to the Baphuon complex. After lunch at a local restaurant, head to Ta Prohm. This temple is considered to be Angkor's most beautiful structure and is overgrown with fig trees, giving a haunting yet exotic atmosphere. The magnificent roots of the trees have merged over the centuries with the temple's huge stone blocks, emphasizing a 'Tomb Raider' feeling.

After lunch at a local restaurant, return to the magnificent Angkor Wat, the crown jewel of Khmer architecture and the national symbol of Cambodia, for an in-depth tour of this amazing complex. Built in the 12th century, Angkor Wat is the world's largest religious monument and a UNESCO World Heritage site, as well as being the best preserved and most religiously significant of the Angkor temples. The temple complex covers 81 hectares and is comparable in size to the Imperial Palace in Beijing. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on the Cambodian flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture. Overnight in Siem Reap. (B,L)

For 26 years, these elephants have given rides to visitors in the temples of the world heritage site. The Kulen Elephant Forest is a haven where these retired elephants can interact freely, and are treated with the greatest care and attention. At the reserve, there are no tricks, no riding, and the elephants are free to roam and socialize as they please.

Your excursion begins with a scenic one-hour drive to Kulen Mountain. After an introductory briefing, head out to meet and greet the elephants with a 2km observation trek through the forest where the elephants are free to roam. After a hot trek the elephants will want to cool off, so you will have the opportunity to watch them play in the cool pond and provide them with some enrichment treats. Enjoy lunch at the lodge or at a local restaurant before continuing on to yet another unforgettable experience.

We'll embark on a culturally inspiring boat trip to Tonle Sap Lake at Kampong Kleang. Tonle Sap, or the Great Lake swells up to seven times its original size during the monsoon season with an ecosystem that is one of the richest and most diverse in the region.
