

Tokyo (Full Day City Tour with Ueno)

Today, enjoy a private tour of several of Tokyo's must-sees. Visit Meiji Jingu Shrine, Tokyo's most famous Shinto Shrine dedicated to the late 19th-century emperor who opened Japan to the West, home to a 40-foot-high torii gate and a 200-acre park made of 1,500-year-old cypress. Next, proceed to Tsukiji Market, the former site of the world's largest fish market, now a vibrant marketplace filled with produce and seafood stands and sushi joints. Continue to Tokyo's oldest Buddhist Temple at Senso-ji in Asakusa followed by a stroll thru its colorful Nakamise Shopping Street.

Last stop of the day is Ueno famed for its Ueno Park comprised temples & shrines, museums, and a zoo. Afterwards, take a stroll through nearby Ameya-Yokocho market that boasts an array of local eats and fresh seafood stands. Return to your hotel. (B)

This morning, proceed to Shinagawa Station by taxi on your own for your Shinkansen to Kyoto. Upon arrival, be met at Kyoto Station by your guide and commence sightseeing of Kyoto.

Visit Kiyomizu Temple, one of the most celebrated temples of Japan founded in 780 on the site of the Otowa Waterfall in the wooded hills east of Kyoto. This UNESCO world heritage site is best known for its wooden stage that juts out from its main hall, 13 meters above the hillside below boasting panoramic views of Kyoto City. Enjoy a stroll through the two famous shopping streets (Ninen-zaka & Sannen-zaka) before reaching Yasaka Shrine. Take a short stroll around Gion District before checking-in to your hotel in Kyoto. (B)

This morning, enjoy a tour of the gems around Western Kyoto. Visit Arashiyama Bamboo Grove famed for its dense bamboo forest with tall, slender stalks that create a unique and peaceful atmosphere. Here, enjoy a 30-minute rickshaw ride through

the bamboo forest. Afterward, continue to Kinkaku-Ji (Golden Pavilion). Originally built as a retirement villa for the Shogun that later became a Buddhist Temple after his death at his request. Today the Golden Pavilion is one of the most photographed sights in all of Kyoto.

Next, visit nearby Ryoan-Ji made popular by its Zen Rock Garden featuring 15 strategically placed stones amid raked gravel. A UNESCO World Heritage site, the garden offers a serene atmosphere that embodies traditional Japanese Zen aesthetics. Return to Kyoto and enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure. (B)

This morning, enjoy a visit to Fushimi Inari Shrine, famous for its thousands of vermilion torii gates straddling a network of trails behind its main buildings leading into the wooded forest of the sacred Mount Inari. Afterwards, travel via Express Train to Nara, on the outskirts of Kyoto. Nara is Japan's first Capital from 710-784 A.D. and an UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit Todaiji Temple, famed for being the world's largest wooden building and houses one of the country's largest Buddha statues. It is adjacent to Nara Park, where over 1,000 free-roaming deer abound. Last stop is Kasuga Taisha, one of the most celebrated shrines in all of Japan. Return to Kyoto in the afternoon. (B)

Today, we'll venture out to nearby Osaka city via a short 30-minute train ride. Osaka, Japan's vibrant culinary and cultural hub, is known for its street food, including takoyaki and okonomiyaki. The city features the iconic Osaka Castle and lively entertainment districts, such as Dotonbori and Namba and various food markets for the food lover. Your tour of the city includes:

- [Osaka Castle](#): a historic castle and fortress, arguably Osaka's most prominent landmark and belies bloody power struggles leading up to the 1603 foundation of the Edo era. The castle features grand architecture, beautiful gardens and showcases Japan's feudal heritage.
- [Osaka Kizu Market](#): Japan's Largest Private Wholesale Food Market
- [Shinsekai](#): Vibrant district in Japan, renowned for its retro charm, delicious street food, and iconic Tsutenkaku Tower
- [Kuromon Ichiba Market](#): Osaka's Kitchen
- Dotonburi & Namba District: vibrant dining and entertainment district famous for shopping and street food!



- Wangjijing Department Store (2nd FL of Basement): an immersive cultural space that brings Beijing of the 1980s to life. Featuring courtyards, old shops, alleys, post offices, snack stalls, and more, it offers a nostalgic journey through time.



Today's highlight takes you to the awe-inspiring Terracotta Museum, the excavated tomb of Qin Shi Huang Di, China's first Emperor. Discovered in 1974 by a group of farmers, this massive burial site is comprised of 7,000+ life-sized Terracotta Warriors and Horses depicting the armies of Qin Shi Huang, constructed to protect the emperor in his afterlife. Return to the city for lunch followed by a visit of the Big Wild Goose Pagoda.

This evening, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant followed by a cultural performance at the famed Tang Dynasty Theatre that showcases the art, music, and dance of the Tang Dynasty. Featuring elaborate costumes, traditional instruments, and captivating choreography, the show offers a stunning portrayal of China's golden age. (B,L,D)



Bangkok (Floating Market & Train Market)

This morning, travel outside Bangkok's hustle and bustle to the countryside visiting the world renowned Floating Market where for over a hundred years, villagers transport their agricultural products by canals to the center of trading at Damnoen Saduak. This incredible network is a labyrinth of almost two hundreds branched canals lined with ancient Thai wooden houses and colorfully decorated by small wooden boats that contain fresh fruits and vegetables. Afterwards, visit the interesting Train Market where local vendors and patrons line the train tracks, quickly disperse and reassemble as the train comes and goes. Return to the city and enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure. (B)
