

Begin your day with a leisurely stroll through the renowned Takayama Morning Market, nestled alongside the picturesque Miyagawa river. This bustling market is a feast for the senses, offering an exquisite array of fresh fruits, verdant vegetables, fragrant flowers, and tempting street snacks. It's a beloved gathering spot for both locals and tourists, each drawn in by the lively ambiance and the opportunity to savor the essence of the town.

Afterwards, take a one-hour express bus ride that takes you through the Japan Alps to Shirakawa-go, a UNESCO World Heritage site, famed for its traditional gassho-zukuri farmhouses some dating 250 years back. Gassho-zukuri translates as 'Praying Hands', as the farmhouses' steep thatched roofs resemble the hands of Buddhist monks pressed together in prayer, and are designed to withstand the heavy snowfalls in this mountainous region. Enjoy a walk through this historical village and up the hill to the observation platform that offers a birds-eye-view of the village and surrounding region.

After the visit, continue by bus (without guide) to Kanazawa. Check-in at your hotel located at **West Exit** of Kanazawa Station. Enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure to relax or explore Kanazawa on your own. (B)

Today, enjoy a full day tour of Kanazawa. We'll start a short walk to Omicho Market, -- the hub of Kanazawa's food culture with rows of fresh seafood and produce. Continue to Kanazawa Castle, the seat of the powerful Maeda Clan from 1583 to the end of the Edo Period. The castle burnt down several times over the centuries and was later rebuilt. On the grounds of Kanazawa castle lies Kenroku-en Garden, one of Japan's three most beautiful traditional garden followed by a private Tea Ceremony at the oldest tea house in Kanazawa in [Gyokusen-Tei](#) set in a serene Japanese garden.

Afterwards, proceed to Higashi Chaya, Kanazawa's famed Old Town lined with wooden homes and shophouses, even the occasional Geisha sighting, for a stroll through this beautifully preserved district. Time and energy permitting, continue to Nagamachi Samurai district and visit the Nomura Samurai House before returning to your hotel. (B)

This morning, proceed to Kanazawa Station for your Shinkansen and Express Train (transfer required at Tsuruga Station) to Kyoto. Upon arrival, be met at Kyoto Station by your guide and commence sightseeing of Kyoto. Visit Fushimi Inari Shrine, famous for its thousands of vermilion torii gates straddling a network of trails behind its main buildings leading into the wooded forest of the sacred Mount Inari. Next, continue to Kiyomizu Temple, one of the most celebrated temples of Japan founded in 780 on the site of the Otowa Waterfall in the wooded hills east of Kyoto. This UNESCO world heritage site is best known for its wooden stage that juts out from its main hall, 13 meters above the hillside below boasting panoramic views of Kyoto City. Enjoy a stroll through the two famous shopping streets (Ninen-zaka & Sannen-zaka) before reaching Yasaka Shrine. Take a short stroll around Gion District before checking-in to your hotel in Kyoto. (B)

Morning at leisure. This afternoon, travel to the outskirts of Kyoto to Nara, Japan's first capital from 710-784 A.D. and yet another UNESCO World Heritage Site. We visit the awe-inspiring Todaiji Temple, famed for being the world's largest wooden building that houses the country's largest Buddha statue; Nara Park, where over 1,000 free-roaming deer abound; and Kasuga Taisha, one of the most celebrated Shrines in all of Japan.

Afterwards, continue to Osaka, highly recognized as Japan's Food Capital. Visit Shinsekai, a vibrant district in Japan, renowned for its retro charm, delicious street food, and iconic Tsutenkaku Tower; followed by Dotonbori, a popular shopping and entertainment district that is lit by hundreds of neon lights and mechanized signs, including the famous Glico Running Man sign and Kani Doraku crab sign.

After enjoying the atmosphere and the shops, stroll through the hundreds of dining outlets featuring all kinds of local delights, including Osaka's famous takoyaki (octopus dumplings), okonomiyaki savory pancakes, ramen noodles, kushikatsu fried skewers, and even Fugu (blowfish). Return to your hotel in Kyoto later this evening. (B,D)

The tour showcases a slow-paced, off-the-beaten-path experience of the countryside to see a different side of Japan.

Your Lake Biwa experience begins with a visit to a local family's residence where we'll enjoy some Mochi-making (Japanese dessert) fun and mingle with the locals. They will first demonstrate Mochi rice cake making following traditional methods and using homegrown rice, then it's your turn to try hand at making your own. It's an experience you'll never forget! Next, enjoy some farm-to-table specialty Sukiyaki (hotpot) made with lots of homegrown vegetables. The farmer will show you how to make it so you bring home their secret recipe.

Afterwards, enjoy leisurely bike ride along a beautiful lakeside and through stunning rice terraces around Biwa. Return to Kyoto on your own the same way. (B,L)

- Sri Maha Mariamman Temple (Hindu Temple)
- Central Market (built in 1930), Sze Yeh Temple (Built in 1880)
- Jamek Mosque (North India Islamic architecture)
- Sultan Abdul Samad Building (Merdeka Square)


