Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia's dynamic capital, offers tourists a blend of modernity and cultural richness. Iconic attractions such as the Petronas Twin Towers and Batu Caves draw crowds, alongside vibrant markets and delicious street food. With its diverse offerings, Kuala Lumpur promises an exciting urban adventure for every traveler.

We'll start the morning with a tour that will take you through the Heritage Trails of the early cultures in Malaysia and insights into Malaysia's multi-cultural society. Visits include:


- Chan See Shu Yuen Clan House (one of the most interesting Clan House in Malaysia)
- China town
- Sri Maha Mariamman Temple (Hindu Temple)
- Central Market (built in 1930), Sze Yeh Temple (Built in 1880)
- Jamek Mosque (North India Islamic architecture)
- Sultan Abdul Samad Building (Merdeka Square)

This afternoon, enjoy additional sightseeing of various city sites of interest or simply spend the day shopping and eating around the city. Candidates include: Petronas Twin Tower (photo stop), King's Palace (photo stop), National Monument, National Museum, National Mosque (photo stop), Sultan Abdul Samad Building. Overnight in Kuala Lumpur. (B)

This morning, we travel by road to explore the birthplace of Malaysia Malacca. Located on the banks of the river which in yesteryear teemed with Chinese junks and spice-laden vessels from all over the world, Malacca provides a glimpse into the splendid saga of an extraordinary empire. Enjoy a 45-minute cruise on the Malacca River followed by a walking tour of Malacca. Visit St. Peter's Church (1710) the oldest Christian Church still in use in Malaysia. Drive past the largest 17th century Chinese cemetery outside of China, located at Bukit Cina, Chinese Hill. Stop at the foothill to view the Sultan's Well before driving through the Portuguese Settlement.

Proceed to view the famous gateway, "Port De Santiago" and the ruins of St. Paul's Church lined by 17th century Dutch tombstones. Next on the list is "Red Square" the salmon pink Dutch administrative building which today house the Malacca Museum and government offices. Visit Christchurch before lunch followed by the "Abode Merciful Clouds" or the Cheng Hoon Teng Temple the only temple where you can find 3 major doctrines of local Chinese belief under the same roof, viz Taoism, Buddhism and Confucianism. Take a stroll along Malacca's Jonker Street before returning back to KL. (B,L)

Kuala Lumpur (Batu Caves)

This morning, take a short drive to the city's outskirts to “Ambassador Row”. Our stop at the Royal Selangor Pewter will feature the largest and most modern pewter factory in the world, reputed internationally for its high quality and craftsmanship. Here, you'll see first hand how these crafts are constructed from casting to polishing to engraving. Next we stop at Batik Factory, see how Batik is designed and printed before continuing onto this morning's main event.

Next up is the the limestone hills of Batu Caves that comprises of three caverns and several smaller caves. It is the shrine of Lord Murugah, a Hindu deity a flight of 272 steps lead up to the temple cave. Another cave, called museum cave, is filled with images of deities and murals depicting scenes from the Hindu scriptures. Return to the hotel and enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure to shop, eat and explore KL on your own. (B)

Penang (Georgetown & Local Markets)

After a light breakfast (suggestion), proceed to the oldest local market in Georgetown where you can find fresh food, cheap clothes and knick-knacks being sold long before the advent air-conditioned supermarkets. There this feeling of cheerfulness and something about these noisy, bustling places which you will find entertaining. Walk past different food stalls offering various morning breakfasts and snacks such as Roti Bakar & Kopi O.

After the market tour, relish the charm and architectural gems of this UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enjoy a walking tour around this heritage town that offers an intimate glimpse into the history and insights into Malaysia's multi-cultural society. Highlights here include:

- St. George's Church, the oldest Anglican church in Southeast Asia.
- Goddess of Mercy Temple, which was first built in 1728, making it Penang's oldest Taoist temple
- Pass through colourful stalls where flower garlands are made.
- Pinang Peranakan Mansion
- Sri Mahamariamman Temple (Hindu Temple)
- Khoo Kongsi, a large Chinese clan-house with elaborate and highly ornamented architecture, a mark of the dominant presence of the Chinese in Penang.

Last stop of the day includes a visit to Wat Chayamangkalaram (Reclining Buddha Temple) and Dharmikarama Burmese Temple famed for its Golden Reclining Buddha statue. Return to the hotel and enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure. (B)

This morning, head to the highest peak of Penang, the must-visit Penang Hill, where the oldest British hill station in the region was established. Enjoy a ride on the Funicular Train up the hill, where you will be amazed by the magnificent Panoramic View of George Town and the Mainland. Next, visit the largest Buddhist temple in Southeast Asia, the Kek Lok Si Temple, also known as the “Temple of Supreme Bliss”. Enjoy a breathtaking sight of the Gigantic Goddess of Mercy Bronze Statue overlooking the entire temple precinct and its vicinity, then take a stroll up the seven-storey Pagoda which houses over 10,000 Buddha statues.

Continue to [The Habitat](#) that offers nature lovers a thrilling treetop adventure with its canopy walk and biodiversity exploration, followed by the Tropical Spice Garden that showcases over 500 species of tropical plants spanning fragrant trails, spice terraces, and herb gardens. Last stop of the day is [Entopia](#), a captivating butterfly sanctuary that offers mesmerizing experiences where visitors encounter diverse insect species amidst vibrant tropical gardens. (B)

This morning, enjoy a fascinating tour that will take you through the urban and rural areas of Langkawi. We'll begin with a visit to a local cottage industry where you will witness that process of traditional batik painting using wax and dyes. Go up the second highest mountain in a cable car ride (conditions permitting) and get bird's eye view of the island along with various

attractions atop (excludes entrance fees). Afterward, visit the Rice Garden, one of Langkawi's eco-tourism attractions, where you will see a long stretch of paddy field and get to learn more about the various plant species. Return to your resort and enjoy the balance of the day at leisure. (B,L)

Note: Cable car rides and entrance fees to various attraction (SkyDome, SkyBridge, etc.) are NOT included. Passengers may purchase combo tickets at time of arrival based on current conditions.

Transfer for your flight to Singapore. Upon arrival, be met and transferred to your hotel for your next 3 nights' accommodations. Enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure to explore the local area.

Later this afternoon, embark on a unique Singapore-by-Night Experience including visits to some of the city's favorite foodies spots. Your visit begins with Gardens by the Bay that spans over 100 hectares with a price-tag over one billion dollars. The gardens house two domes - Cloud Forest and Flower Dome, which are climate-controlled indoor glasshouses. The Flower Dome (the larger of the two) replicates the cool-dry climate of the Mediterranean and South Africa, whilst the Cloud Forest replicates a cool-moist climate found in Tropical Montane regions such as Mount Kinabalu in Sabah and high elevation areas in South America. Within the gardens are also 18 impressive-looking Supertrees (tree-like structures), which are vertical gardens up to 50 metres tall and perform a multitude of functions. Moving on to the newest attraction in Singapore at Next visit the iconic Marina Bay Sands SkyPark. Crowning the three hotel towers of Marina Bay Sands at 200 metres in the sky, the Sands SkyPark is home to the world's largest public cantilever housing a public observatory deck, lush gardens.

Next, head over to Newton Food center located next to the Central Business District with charming Victorian wrought-iron structure, that is usually dismissed this way by Singaporeans. Newton is the actual location for the street food fest in the film that's had critics salivating. With close to 100 stalls, it's no wonder this food centre got chosen to be featured in Crazy Rich Asians. Amongst some of Singaporean's favorites are: Hup Kee Fried Oyster Omelette, Kwee Heng Duck Noodle, Kwang Kee Teochew Fish Porridge, Bee Heng Popiah, Soon Wah Fishball Kway Teow Mee (for fishball noodles) and Chong Pang Huat, for barbecued chicken wings. Time permitting, continue to Chinatown, another foodies spot in a bustling atmosphere where local eateries, traditional shophouses and vibrant markets abound before returning to your hotel. (B)
