Bali (Gems of Central Bali by Bike and By Foot)

Morning drive to Kintamani. This is a stunning starting point, with views (weather permitting) over the active volcano Mount Batur, which sits alongside Lake Batur, and the surrounding landscape of Central Bali. Then, climb on your bikes and wind your way downhill through the colorful tapestry that is the Balinese countryside. You will do several stops en-route, taking in key sights and interesting highlights, passing through scenic traditional Balinese villages, local temples, and lush green rice

paddies. Return via the amazing rice terraces of Tegalalang and visit the town's art market. Known locally as Pasar Seni, this colourful marketplace has a wide range of items on display including clothing, textiles, leather goods and locally designed jewelry. Wind your way back to Ubud with lunch served at a local restaurant. (B,L)

This very early morning (2am!), proceed by road to Mount Batur followed by an invigorating hike up to the summit in time for sunrise. Starting your ascent at 1200m above sea level, the trek to the summit (1717m) will take between 1½ and 2 hours. The reward for the early wakeup call is a stunning vista of the surrounding countryside as well as views of the crater itself. After a simple breakfast it is time to make the descent, allowing time to visit en-route the three younger craters and any recent lava flow.

Toya Bungkah Hot Springs is the next stop on today's itinerary. Located in the village of Penelokan, there are two natural pools at these hot springs and legend has it that the heated mineral water inside them is said to cure all sorts of ailments. Enjoy a soothing dip in the pools before returning to your resort. Enjoy the balance of the day to relax, enjoy the resort and explore Ubud Town. (B)

The labyrinthine streets of Ha Noi's Old Quarter are the ideal place in which to wander and observe daily life while the elegant French Quarter is home to some fine colonial

architecture including the famous Sofitel Legend Metropole Hotel and the Opera House. Hanoi is steeped in history from the 'Hanoi Hilton' to the religious pride of the 11th century Temple of Literature, it's a delightful city of contrasts to soak up the ebbs and flows of life in Vietnam.

This evening, embark on a culinary adventure for which Hanoi is known. Hanoi and its environs are the birthplace of many quintessential Vietnamese dishes and the city is considered one of the world's great food capitals. Experience Vietnam's vibrant food culture walking through the maze of bustling streets that make up Hanoi's Old Quarter. Tempt your taste buds with the famed Hanoi dish Banh Cuon at a local eatery. Watch in awe as the skilled chefs demonstrate for you how this tasty dish is put together. Your next two snack stops are at outdoor barbeque stalls. Sit down with the Hanoi locals and sample various meat, vegetable, and bread specialties that are flame-grilled over hot coals for extra flavor.

It's then time for dessert as you venture down a small alley to join in the local tradition of feasting on fresh fruit served in a cup and smothered with crushed iced and condensed milk. Before return to the hotel, you will be taken to one of Hanoi's best kept secrets, a hidden café with stunning views over the picturesque Hoan Kiem Lake. If coffee is not your style, a cold beer awaits! (B,D)

This morning, enjoy a city tour of Hanoi. We'll start with the Museum of Ethnology, dedicated to preserving the cultural traditions of Vietnam's 54 ethnic groups. Next head to the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first university built in the 1970s followed by Hoa Lo Prison where the late John McCain was held captive for 5 years.

Continue to Train Street and enjoy a bit of interaction with local street vendors before sitting down to enjoy a cold drink. Cap off the morning with a cyclo (rickshaw) ride through the famed Old Quarters, a local market place that dates back to the 13th century that comprises of a labyrinth of narrow streets and alleyways, each named after the goods that were traditionally sold there, such as silk, silver, or herbs. Today, these streets are still bustling with activity, with vendors selling all kinds of goods, from clothes and souvenirs to food and household items. We'll Stop at a roadside coffee shop, mingle with the locals and enjoy the daily life passing by. Return to the hotel and enjoy the afternoon at leisure to freshen up or explore the lively area around your hotel.

This evening, enjoy Sofitel Metropole's exclusive hotel guests-only "[The Path of History Tour](#)" that features the historic hotel's underground bomb shelter that protected guests from air raids during the Vietnam-American War that was later unearthed in 2011. (B)

If you're up for an early start (4:45am pick-up), experience the beauty and tranquility of Angkor Wat at Sunrise. Angkor Wat, the crown jewel of Khmer architecture and the national symbol of Cambodia. Angkor Wat is the largest, best preserved, and most religiously significant of the Angkor temples.

The temple complex covers 81 hectares and is comparable in size to the Imperial Palace in Beijing. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on the Cambodian flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime

example of classical Khmer art and architecture. Angkor impresses visitors both by its sheer scale and beautifully proportioned layout, as well as the delicate artistry of its carvings. Angkor Wat is stunning at any time of the day, but sunrise and sunset are especially beautiful times to watch the play of light on the stones.

After lunch, head to the picturesque Ta Prohm by E-Bike. This temple is considered to be Angkor's most beautiful structure and is overgrown with fig trees, giving a haunting yet exotic atmosphere. The magnificent roots of the trees have merged over the centuries with the temple's huge stone blocks, emphasizing a 'forgotten city' feeling.

Next up is Angkor Thom, the ancient royal city of the Khmer Empire with its centrepiece; the Bayon temple. Although it may look like a shapeless mass of stone, further scrutiny reveals towers with enigmatic faces of former King Jayavarman VII. Continue to the Terrace of the Elephants, which served as a platform from where the King could welcome back his victorious army and the Terrace of the Leper King, which holds perfect carvings winding along a narrow passageway that leads to the Baphuon complex. Overnight in Siem Reap. (B,L)

Tip: This evening, head out to Pub Street just a short taxi or tuk-tuk ride away for dinner, entertainment, shopping and nightlife!

Siem Reap (Tonle Sap Lake, Banteay Srei, Banteay Samre)

This morning, travel to the Cambodian countryside for a change of pace starting with Banteay Srei Temple famous for its delicate carvings in pink sandstone widely praised as the "Jewel of Khmer Art". Continue to Banteay Samrae, built under Suryavarman II and Yasovarman II in the early 12th century, it is a Hindu temple in the Angkor Wat style. Named after the Samré, an ancient people of Indochina, the temple uses the same materials as Banteay Srei.

Located in the heart of Cambodia, this extraordinary lake swells up to seven times its original size during the monsoon season with an ecosystem that is one of the richest and most diverse in the region. Traveling by boat, we explore the floating fishing villages that live at the edges of the lake, passing submerged forests and fishing farms. Return to Siem Reap in the afternoon. (B,L)


