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

Today's program features New Delhi, the new capital designed by Sir Edward Lutyens that was built between 1911 to 1929. Drive past the Presidential Palace, the Rashtrapati Bhavan and the secretariat buildings, the impressive Rajpath to the World War I memorial arch, the India Gate, the High Court Building and the Old Fort. Visit Humayun's Tomb, ruins of Quwat-ul-Eslam (Light of Islam) Mosque and Iron Pillar, which dates back to the 4th century AD. Finish the day with a visit to Qutab Minar - the 72 meter high ruins of Quwat-ul-Islam Mosque dating back to the 4th century that still stands today. Afternoon at leisure to relax and explore the city on your own. (B)

Tuesday · October 22nd



Enjoy a morning tour of Old Delhi starting with the Red Fort (outside only on Mondays), the 300-year-old walled city built of red sandstone that dates back to the very peak of the Mughal power. Opposite the fort are the black and white onion dome and

minarets of the Jama Masjid, the largest and most elegant mosque in India. Drive past Kotla Firoze Shah, ruins of an old fort of the 14th century with the 13 meter high Ashoka Pillar, dating back to the 3rd century BC. Visit Raj Ghat, where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated in 1948. Next, enjoy a stroll or rickshaw ride around Chandni Chowk, one of the oldest and busiest markets in Old Delhi lined with stalls of spices, dried fruit, silver jewelry and vivid saris. Return to your hotel and enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure. (B)

Wednesday · October 23rd



After breakfast, travel overland to Agra by private car (approx. 4 hours). Agra was the capital of the Mughal court during the 16th and 17th centuries and its sublime monuments date from that era. The emperors Akbar, Jahangir and Shah Jehan governed their vast empires from here and as prolific builders; artisans of Persia, Central Asia and other parts of India were attracted by their patronage. The resulting luxurious palaces, tombs, forts and gardens dot the picturesque riverside region along the Yamuna River; three of which, the Taj Mahal, the Agra Fort and Fatehpur Sikri have been declared UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

Upon arriving in Agra, visit the magnificent Taj Mahal (Closed on Friday), built by Emperor Shahjahan in white marble in the early 1600's for his beloved Queen Mumtaz Mahal. With its incredible lacy white grandeur, the Taj Mahal is perhaps the most perfect architectural monument in the world. Next, visit Agra Fort. Situated on the banks of the River Yamuna, Agra Fort is comprised of palaces, mosques and audience halls, all contained within its massive wall of red sandstone. It is a perfect example of blending Islamic and Hindu traditions. Overnight in Agra. (B)

Enjoy a full day sightseeing of Jaipur, popularly known as the pink city was built by Raja Jai Singh in the 18th century. It is surrounded by hills topped with rugged fortresses, dotted with fairy-tale palaces. Ambling camels and brightly-dressed peasants, reflect Jaipur's desert heritage. This picturesque city sits in desert land encircled by rugged ranges of the Aravallis. These ranges are crowned with medieval fortresses reminiscent of the days when the Rajputs fought fierce battle and long drawn out wars to protect their beloved land from invaders.

Highlights today begin with a visit to Amer Fort (with jeep ride), a marvelous example of Rajput architecture with its terraces and ramparts reflected in the Mata Lake below. The Fort interior has various royal halls decorated with intricate ivory work, exquisite wall paintings and tiny mirror chips. Continue to Jantar Mantar Observatory, the largest and best preserved observatory where astronomical instruments remain in use.

In the afternoon, visit City Palace, a delightful blend of Mughal and traditional Rajasthani architecture that sprawls over one-seventh of the area in the walled city; followed by Hawa Mahal, or "Palace of Winds", a five-story structure of sandstone plastered pink encrusted with fine trelliswork and elaborate balconies and a prominent landmark in Jaipur. Overnight in Jaipur. (B)

Jaipur / Guwahati / Brahmaputra River Cruise

Transfer to Jaipur airport for your early morning flight to Guwahati (via Kolkata). Upon arrival, be met by an Assam Bengal Navigation (ABN) representative and transferred to your Brahmaputra River Cruise.

Begin cruising downstream to Sualkuchi, a bustling little town that is the centre of Assamese silk production. Visit a local weaving workshop and witness the whole process of silk manufacturing - from cocoon and spinning to dyeing and hand-weaving into exquisite mekhela chadars (a two-piece sari, the traditional attire of an Assamese woman). Return to your cruise for dinner and overnight. (B,D)



Today, you drive to Kaziranga's Central Range for a morning jeep safari. Enjoy lunch at Diphlu River Lodge before taking another jeep safari in the little visited Burapahar Range before returning to the boat.

Covering an area of approximately 430 sq kms, the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Kaziranga National Park is home to the world's largest population of the Indian One-Horned Rhinoceros as well as the Indian Wild Water Buffalo. It has also earned the distinction of having the highest density of Royal Bengal Tigers (one every five sq. km.), making this park an incredibly rich biodiversity hotspot. With its marshy swamps and thickets of elephant grass, the park supports large populations of Indian elephants, Indian bison, swamp deer, and Capped Langurs.

Kaziranga National Park frequently draws comparisons to the Serengeti in Africa due to the park's abundance of wildlife and birds and is considered a birding paradise. Bird species found here include the Oriental Honey Buzzard, Black-shouldered Kite, White-tailed Eagle, Himalayan Griffon and many more. (B,L,D)



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

After breakfast, enjoy a morning excursion to the Elephanta Caves with a one-hour boat ride through the forested island of Elephanta, one of the most atmospheric places in Mumbai. Populated only by a small fishing community, it makes a wonderful contrast to the seething claustrophobia of the city. One of the highlights here is the unique cave temple excavated between the 5th and 8th centuries, whose massive Trimurti Shiva sculpture is a fine example of Hindu architecture.

Afterwards, return to civilization with a tour of Mumbai. Visit the Gateway of India, an Indo Saracenic style of architecture (1927), designed by George Witted to commemorate the visit of George V and Queen Mary in 1911. Drive past the Victoria Terminus, the most remarkable example of Victorian Gothic architecture in India opened during Queen Victoria's Golden Jubilee Year. Visit the Hanging Gardens so named since they are located on top of a series of tanks that supply water to Bombay. And last but not the least, make a brief photo stop at "Dhobi Ghat" the Indian laundry system before returning to your hotel in the afternoon. (B)

Situated at an altitude of 4500ft and founded in the 8th Century A.D. the valley of Kathmandu is composed of three royal Cities, Kathmandu, Patan & Bhadgaon. The valley surrounded by green hills topped off by snow capped peaks covers an area of 218 sq. miles. Kathmandu has always been a renowned center for Hinduism and Buddhism where you will find the stupa of Swayambhunath, Bouddhanath and hundreds of temples depicting both the religion, where legend and reality live side by side.

Today's program begins with Kathmandu Durbar Square. Famed for its old temples and places, epitomizes the religious and cultural life of the people, it is here where the Kings of Nepal were crowned and their coronations solemnized. Enjoy a stroll through the various landmarks and monuments within the square including Taleju Temple, Kal Bhairav (statue of King Pratap Malla), the Big Bell, Big Drum, and Kumari (Temple of Living goddess).

Next, visit Swayambhunath, one of the world's most glorious Buddhist Stupa dating back around 2000 years. The Stupa, which forms the main structure, is made of brick and clay supporting the lofty conical spire capped by a pinnacle of copper gilt. Painted on the four-sides of the spire base are the eyes of Lord Buddha. It is perhaps the best place to observe the religious harmony of Buddhist and Hindu, and boasts an excellent view of the Kathmandu Valley.

Continue to Patan Durbar Square famed for its cluster of fine pagoda temples and stone statues. At every step one comes across a piece of art or an image of a deity, testifying to the consummate skill of Patan's anonymous artists. Overnight in Kathmandu. (B)

Kathmandu (Pasupatinath & Bouddhanath)

Today, visit Pasupatinath Temple, renowned for its superb architecture, its two storied golden roof and silver doors. It is one of the holiest Hindu temples dedicated to Lord Shiva. Its sacred grounds, adorned with intricate architecture and rituals, draw pilgrims and tourists alike. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, it stands as a testament to Nepal's rich religious and cultural heritage. While entry into the temple grounds is only permitted for Hindus, others can observe temple and rituals from the eastern bank of the Bagmati, where people cremate the dead.

Afterwards, visit Bouddhanath, also known as Boudha, it is a revered Buddhist stupa that contains the relics of Kashyap Buddha. This UNESCO World Heritage Site stands as a symbol of Tibetan Buddhism's presence in the region. Its massive dome, adorned with colorful prayer flags and intricate designs, attracts pilgrims and visitors seeking spiritual solace. Encircling the stupa are monasteries, shops, and cafes, creating a vibrant atmosphere where tradition and modernity harmoniously coexist, making it one of the must-visits in Kathmandu. Return to your hotel and enjoy the balance of the day at leisure to relax and explore Kathmandu on your own. (B)


