

### Tokyo (Akihabara, Asakusa, Sumida River Cruise & Hamarikyu)

Today, enjoy a private tour of several of Tokyo's must-sees using public transportation. Our first stop today is Asakusa, Tokyo's historic district known for Senso-ji Temple, traditional shops, and Nakamise-dori street market, offering a glimpse into Tokyo's cultural heritage and lively atmosphere. Enjoy a 2-hour Sumo show and lunch (12pm-2pm) at Asakusa Sumo Club. Next, enjoy a 40-minute cruise along the Sumida River and Tokyo Bay for Hamarikyu that features traditional Japanese landscaping, teahouses, and a large tidal pond offering serene views amidst the urban bustle.

Afterwards, proceed to Akihabara. Dubbed Electric Town, this area was originally famous for its many electronics shops sporting the latest and greatest Japanese electronics, as well as the center of Japan's otaku (diehard fan) culture filled anime-themed shops, and now home to the massive 6-storey newly opened Namco Game Center. Return to your hotel. (B)

Today, enjoy a full day tour of the city by private vehicle. Visit Tsukiji Market, the former site of the world's largest fish market, now a vibrant marketplace filled with produce and seafood stands and sushi joints. Continue to nearby Art Aquarium, a captivating exhibition blending art, technology, and marine life through vibrant displays of illuminated goldfish tanks.

Enjoy lunch at Ramen Street (at own expense) and a stroll about the Ginza District (time permitting) before proceeding to the super cool Teamlab Planets Museum, a fascinating digital art museum where visitors wade through mesmerizing light installations, interactive projections, and sensory experiences, blurring the boundaries between art and reality. Time permitting, our final stop of the day is Shimokitazawa, an off-the-tourist-path neighborhood renowned for its vintage shops, indie boutiques, live music venues, and laid-back atmosphere popular amongst young Tokyoites seeking unique fashion and artsy vibes.



Start the day with a visit to Takayama's famed morning market set along side the Miyagawa River. Stroll through the vibrant marketplace lined with colorful stalls and shophouses selling fresh local produce and mouthwatering snacks. Afterwards, proceed to Shirakawa-go, a UNESCO World Heritage site, famed for its traditional gassho-zukuri farmhouses some dating 250 years back. Gassho-zukkuri translates as 'Praying Hands', as the farmhouses' steep thatched roofs resemble the hands of Buddhist monks pressed together in prayer, and are designed to withstand the heavy snowfalls in this mountainous region.

This afternoon, visit Hida Furukawa, a sleepy, off-the-tourist-path heritage town near Takayama where a glimpse of Old Japan awaits famed for its Koi filled canals, artisan crafts and sake breweries. Return to Takayama and enjoy the balance of the afternoon/evening at leisure. (B)

This morning, proceed to Takayama Station by hotel shuttle for Express Train + Shinkansen (transfer required at Nagoya Station) to Kyoto. Upon arrival, be met at Kyoto Station by your guide and commence sightseeing of Kyoto. Visit Nijo Castle showcasing exquisite 17th-century architecture surrounded by picturesque gardens. Its "nightingale floors" create melodic sounds, while historic significance and cultural richness make it a must-visit landmark.

Next, continue to Kiyomizu Temple, one of the most celebrated temples of Japan founded in 780 on the site of the Otowa Waterfall in the wooded hills east of Kyoto. This UNESCO world heritage site is best known for its wooden stage that juts out from its main hall, 13 meters above the hillside below boasting panoramic views of Kyoto City. Enjoy a stroll through the two famous shopping streets (Ninen-zaka & Sannen-zaka) before reaching Yasaka Shrine. Take a short stroll around Gion District before checking-in to your hotel in Kyoto. (B)

## Kyoto (Hozugawa River Trip, Arashiyama, Golden Pavilion, Nishiki Market)

This morning, enjoy a 30 minute ride to Kameoka for a two-hour river trip along Hozugawa river. This boat ride features breathtaking views of forested mountains, rapids, and serene landscapes. Upon disembarkation, visit Arashiyama Bamboo Grove famed for its dense bamboo forest with tall, slender stalks that create a unique and peaceful atmosphere. Here, enjoy a 30-minute rickshaw ride through the forest followed by visits to the Tenryuji Temple and a stroll across Togetsukyo Bridge (time permitting).

Continue to Kinkaku-Ji (Golden Pavilion). Originally built as a retirement villa for the Shogun that later became a Buddhist Temple after his death at his request. Return to the city center and enjoy a stroll through Nishiki Market (a.k.a. Kyoto's Kitchen) followed by a visit to the Samurai & Ninja Museum. Return your hotel on your own afterwards just a short walk away. (B)

## Kyoto (Lake Biwa Countryside Excursion with Mochi-making)

This morning, make your own way to Kyoto Station where you'll be met by your guide who will accompany you on a 30-minute train ride to Lake Biwa. Here, we'll spend a relaxing and culturally-inspiring day in a traditional farm village mingling with the locals. The tour showcases a slow-paced, off-the-beaten-path experience of the countryside to see a different side of Japan.

Your Lake Biwa experience features a visit to a local family's residence where we'll enjoy some Mochi-making (Japanese dessert) fun and mingle with the locals. They will first demonstrate Mochi rice cake making following traditional methods and using homegrown rice, then it's your turn to try hand at making your own. It's an experience you'll never forget! Afterwards, enjoy some farm-to-table specialty Sukiyaki (hotpot) made with lots of homegrown vegetables. The farmer will show you how to make it so you bring home their secret recipe. Return to Kyoto on your own the same way. (B,L)

## Kyoto (Full Day Fushimi Inari & Nara Tour)

This morning, travel to Nara, Japan's first Capital (710-784 A.D.) and an UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit Todaiji Temple, famed for being the world's largest wooden building and houses one of the country's largest Buddha statues. It is adjacent to Nara Park, where over 1,000 free-roaming deer abound. Last stop is Kasuga Taisha, one of the most celebrated shrines in all of Japan.

Return to Kyoto for a visit to Gekkeikan Museum, one of Japanese Oldest Sake Breweries in Japan. Continue to Fushimi Inari Shrine, famous for its thousands of vermilion torii gates straddling a network of trails behind its main buildings leading into the wooded forest of the sacred Mount Inari.

This morning, board a shinkansen for Osaka, stopping in Himeji en-route. Himeji Castle is famous for being Japan's best preserved castles, and only 1 of 12 original castles remaining in all of Japan. It has been declared a National Treasure and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Continue on your own to Shin-Osaka Station. Upon arrival, proceed to your hotel by taxi (approx. 20 minutes). Later this afternoon, enjoy a night foodies tour of Osaka (a.k.a. Japan's Kitchen) strolling popular food and entertainment districts such

as Shinsekai, Osaka Jan Jan Yokocho and Dotonburi sampling the city's local favorites such as Takoyaki, okonomiyaki (savory pancakes), ramen, and/or fried kushikatsu skewers. (B,D)
