### **TOUR ITINERARY**

Day	Activity Summary
Feb. 25/26	<b>Depart USA:</b> Late night/early morning (Feb. 26 @1:30am) departure for Bangkok via Cathay Pacific Airways, connecting in Hong Kong.
Feb. 27	Arrive Bangkok: Upon evening arrival in Bangkok, be met and transferred to Renaissance Bangkok for your next 2 nights' accommodations. Enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure to relax and explore Bangkok on your own.
	<b>Tip:</b> Enjoy a cocktail at Centara Grand Hotel's "Red Sky" Rooftop Bar/Restaurant located walking distance from your hotel; or at Banyan Tree's Vertigo, both offering spectacular views of the Thai Capital in an upscale setting.
Feb. 28	Bangkok (Floating Market at Tha Kha): After an early breakfast, proceed to the less touristy Floating Market at Tha Kha (opens on weekends only). Tha Kha floating market offers a hugely rewarding experience as local people come to barter, where for over a hundred years, villagers transport their agricultural products by canals to this trading center. Afterwards, visit the interesting Train Market where local vendors line the train tracks, quickly dispersing as the train approaches the bustling market.
	After lunch at a local restaurant, enjoy a city tour of Bangkok with visits to Royal Grand Palace and its Emerald Buddha, Wat Trimit (Golden Buddha), and Wat Pho (Reclining Buddha) for a "Monk Blessing Ceremony", a very special Thai custom by personally presenting alms to the monk at the temple while receiving the monks' blessing. (B,L)

Feb. 29	Bangkok / Chiang Mai: Transfer to the airport for your morning flight for Chiang Mai. Upon arrival, embark on a boat trip along the Maeping to observe the region's rural way of life. Afterwards, take a tour of Chiang Mai city visiting a local market, the Old City and several of the city's famous temples. Accommodations at Puripunn Baby Grand Hotel. (B)
	Tip: A visit to the Night Bazaar is a must, located 10-15 minutes by foot from your hotel (complimentary tuk-tuk service also available at your hotel).
Mar. 01	Chiang Mai (Elephant Safari & Whitewater Rafting): Set in a beautiful jungle setting, approximately 60-km north of Chiang Mai on the banks of the Ping River, lies the Chiang Dao Elephant Camp. We will witness an enthralling display of elephant training and tricks as the trainers (mahouts) command their respective elephants to display the skills they once used in the logging industry. You will have a chance to ride on an elephant for one hour to the forest. After lunch, drive through unspoiled village in Mae Teang and embark on an inflatable raft down the rapids in the white and scenic Mae Tang River for about 45 minutes. After some recreation and refresh yourself, continue to Baan Huai Rai, passing several villages before returning to your resort. (B,L)
	Tip: Samsen Restaurant offers authentic Thai Cuisine in an upscale, riverside setting located just a few minutes from your hotel by Tuk Tuk.
Mar. 02	Chiang Mai (Doi Suthep): This morning, drive up Doi Suthep mountain to visit the most sacred temple in all of Northern Thailand. Tour the spectacular grounds of Wat Phra That Doi Suthep, located high above Chiang Mai City at a altitude of 5,000+ ft. Return to your resort and enjoy the balance of your afternoon at leisure. (B)
Mar. 03	Chiang Mai (Phrao Eco Trek): This morning, depart on an open air local truck traveling north along the most scenic routes to Phrao district passing teak forests and local farms. Continue more North to Karen hill tribe village, one of 6 main hill-tribe minorities in the northern Thailand. Here, embark on a trek up mountain through natural forest where you can learn about a variety of fauna and local customs. Arrive at Nature Lodge with a chance to mingle with Lahu hill tribe villages before visiting Buatong waterfall for a refreshing dip. Includes picnic lunch. (B,L)
Mar. 04	Chiang Mai: Full day free at leisure to relax and explore Chiang Mai on your own. Optional tours (cooking lesson, zip-line adventure, etc.) are available upon request. (B)
Mar. 05	Chiang Mai / Phuket: Transfer for your morning flight to Phuket. Upon arrival, be met and transferred to Katathani Resort & Spa for your next 3 nights' accommodations. (B)
Mar. 06	Phuket: Full day free at leisure in Paradise to relax and explore beautiful Phuket. (B)
	<b>Tip:</b> For nightlife, visit the Patong Beach Strip (approx. 15-20 minutes from your resort by taxi) lined with a host of restaurants (many with live music), shops, massage parlors, bars and night clubs.
Mar. 07	Phuket: Full day free at leisure. (B)
Mar. 08	Phuket / Koh Yao Yai: Morning transfer by private car to Ao Po Pier and board the Santhiya Speedboat to Koh Yao Yai (25 minute ride). Check in at the beautiful Santhiya Resort for your next 4 nights accommodations. (B) ****NOTE: early check-in subject to availability***
	<ol> <li>Santhiya offers complimentary morning Yoga session as well as free use of kayaks and bicycles for hotel guests. Please inquire at check-in.</li> <li>There are several local restaurants with good inexpensive local food steps from Santhiya. Facing the resort, walk to the right past the hotel adjacent to the Santhiya you will find a few fruit stands with a small road to "town". Continue on the road for about 50 yards for local eats and small groceries stores.</li> </ol>
