TOUR OUTLINE

Day	Activity Summary
Feb. 11/12	Depart USA: Depart LAX on a late evening flight for Siem Reap via Cathay Pacific Airways, connecting in Hong Kong.
Feb. 13	Arrive Siem Reap: Upon morning arrival in Siem Reap, be met and transferred to Angkor Miracle Hotel for your next 2 nights' accommodations (NOTE: Early check-in is subject to hotel availability). This afternoon, embark on a by a culturally inspiring boat trip to Tonle Sap Lake at Kempong. Tonle Sap, or the Great Lake, swells up to seven times its original size during the monsoon season with an ecosystem that is one of the richest and most diverse in the region. Explore the lake's primitive floating fishing communities by boat, passing submerged forests and fishing farms. Return to Siem and the afternoon.
Feb. 14	Siem Reap: This morning, enjoy a tour of the magnificent Angkor Wat, the most impressive of Angkorian Temples and the symbol of Cambodia. Afterwards, visit the fortified city of ANGKOR THOM that covers an area of 10 square km enclosed by a wall and wide moats. Next visit, Ta Prohm - one of the most popular attractions of Angkor as much of the jungle has not been cleared and it looks very much as most of the Angkor monuments would have appeared when European explorers first stumbled across them. 


Feb. 15	Siem Reap / Can Tho: Enjoy a morning visit of Banteay Srei Temple. Seemingly miniature in comparison to the other Angkor temples, BANTEAY SREI is considered to be the jewel of classical Khmer art. Built in pink sandstone, the walls are covered in exquisitely preserved carvings of unusual delicacy. Afterwards, visit the mid 12 th century temple of Banteay Samre before boarding an afternoon flight for HCM City. Upon arrival, proceed to Can Tho (approx. 4 hours) by road and check-in at Victoria Hotel for your overnight accommodation. (B)
Feb. 16	Can Tho / HCM City: Enjoy an early morning excursion to Southeast Asia's largest and most bustling floating Market at Cai Rang. We explore the floating market by long tailed boat dotted with fruit and vegetable vendors from all over the region where buyers and vendors have haggling and trading for centuries. Continue on to explore the quiet canals and backwaters in the delta before traveling by road northbound to the Upper Mekong Delta at Ben Tre. Take a boat ride on Ben Tre river to observe the daily life along river and visit several local villages famous for their respective crafts with lunch at a local restaurant. Continue by road to to HCM City and check-in at Pullman Saigon Hotel for your overnight accommodation. (B,L)
Feb. 17	HCM City / Hoi An: Enjoy a morning city tour of HCM City visiting Notre Dame Cathedral, Reunification palace, Hotel de Ville (City Hall), Opera House, Central Post Office and Ben Thanh Market. Board an afternoon flight for Danang. Transfer to Hoi and check-in at the Sunrise Resort for your next 3 nights' accommodations. (B)
Feb. 18	Hoi An: This morning, enjoy a ride on a Buffalo cart through the amazing countryside to a wharf in Cam Thanh for a boat ride along Hoi An river to TRA QUE vegetable village. Take part in the numerous activities including: raking soil, preparing soil to grow vegetables and sow seeds, cultivating vegetables and watering greens. Learn how to make white rice from brown rice: grind paddy by husking mill, winnow, pound and sift rice; grind white rice to make wet flour and make rice cakes. Sample local before returning to Hoi An town for a boat trip down the Thu Bon River visiting a wood carving and pottery village en-route. Overnight in Hoi An. (B)
Feb. 19	Hoi An: Full day free at leisure to relax, explore Hoi An on your own as well observing the festivities of the Lunar New Year (Tet). (B)
Feb. 20	Hoi An / Hanoi: Early morning transfer to the airport for your flight to Hanoi. Upon arrival, commence a city tour of Vietnam's Capital visiting Hanoi's Old Quarters, one Pillar pagoda, Temple of Literature, Hoan Kiem Lake, the Opera House, Museum of Ethnology and "Hanoi Hilton" prison. Overnight at Movenpick Hotel. (B)
Feb. 21	Hanoi / Halong Bay: Morning overland transfer to Halong Bay. Upon arrival, board your privately chartered Halong Legend Cruise for a fantastic cruise around Halong Bay. Activities today a visit to a floating fishing village, wine tasting, a cooking lesson and "squid fishing". Lunch and dinner are served on board. (B,L,D)
Feb. 22	Halong Bay / Luang Prabang: This morning, try a Tai Chi lesson and work up your appetite for brunch. Feb. 23	Luang Prabang: Morning tour of Luang Prabang Town visiting the local morning market and the famous temples for which this UNESCO World Heritage Site is famous. Visits include: Wat Visoun, Wat Aham, Wat Xieng Thong, the National Museum (Royal Palace) and Wat Mai. Afternoon free at leisure to relax and explore Luang Prabang on your own. (B)
